This eight-hour classroom course is designed especially for motorists age 50 and older. Learn eight strategies to continue to drive safely; how to share the road; driving in all types of conditions; becoming more familiar with road signs, signals, and markings; new car technology; and when to curtail driving. This informal, stress-free class enables drivers over 50 to become eligible for a discount in their auto insurance rates for the next three years and to reduce their chances of having an accident.

AARP Safe Driving- Refresher Course

The four-hour classroom course is a Refresher course covering the effects of aging on driving, provides strategies to combat these effects and to continue to drive safely. Drivers over 50 become eligible to receive a discount in their auto insurance rates for three years and their chances of having an accident are greatly reduced. To take the course, students must show that they have attended this in a similar safe driving class within the past three years.

1. FAX

For 24 hour service, you can FAX your "[Registration Form](#)" anytime! FAX to **215-968-8320**, and be sure to provide all the registration information. Be sure to include your Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover card number, expiration date and security code.

2. On-Line - Credit Card Only

You can scroll down to further review the same courses and descriptions as on the "Course Descriptions" tab on this site; when you are ready to check seat availability and register, write down the Course Codes (5 letters with 4 numbers):

A) Click on "[Register Online Now](#)" in the blue oval in the upper right corner, B) Select "[Con Ed & Camps](#)", C) In the lower right corner, select "[Search and Register for Con Ed Classes](#)", D) Fill in the Course Code and select "Submit" to see the details and availability.

5. Walk-In
