I. Call to Order

Vice Chair Minnucci called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. and noted that H.A.R.B. did have a quorum.

II. Approval of Minutes – September 10th, 2018

Upon a Motion by Nancy Ruddle, seconded by Marnie Newman, H.A.R.B. unanimously agreed to approve the minutes of September 10th, 2018.

III. New Business

A. Action on Alison Levine 6296 Fleecydale Road, Carversville, PA (Carversville Historic District) HARB Plan Number 2018-10-H

Ms. Alison Levine was present on behalf of the application.

Upon a Motion by Scott Minnucci, seconded by Marnie Newman, it was unanimously agreed to recommend issuance of a Certificate of Appropriateness to TMP#41-002-055, 6296 Fleecydale Road, to replace the existing cedar shingles roof with CertainTeed Presidential Shake, weathered wood color, to replicate the look of cedar shakes with the performance of fiber glass construction, and to replace the existing copper flashing with new copper as needed. If trim needs repair or replacement the paint will be matched to the existing color (Historic Ivory).

It was noted that HARB members felt the need to add more detail to the Guidelines regarding the lighting standards for up-lighting and walkway lighting on commercial and residential properties. HARB wanted to reach out to the Township Manager to provide someone with expertise for lighting issues in order to help in revising the lighting details in the Guidelines.

Marnie Newman mentioned she would speak at the Carversville Historic Society's meeting on Monday (11/12/18) to speak about the Solebury Township RRIK application and process. The following information was discussed:

- RRIK Ordinance was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on November 21, 2017
- There have been 9 RRIK applications submitted to the Township since adoption of the RRIK Ordinance
