SOLEBURY TOWNSHIP SUMMER CAMP HEALTH & SAFETY PLAN

Summer programs that provide child care, enrichment and recreational activities for children and youth are permitted to operate in accordance with the State of Pennsylvania guidelines and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidance for youth and summer camps. Masking requirements are optional for everyone.

MASKING:

- Optional for all staff, campers, and parents.
- Masks will be available for those who request one.

SANITATION:

- Bathrooms are cleaned and disinfected frequently throughout the week, including all surfaces within the camp facility.
- Power-wash, clean and disinfect the camp playground and apparatus.
- Frequently clean and disinfect sports equipment, balls, etc.

HYGIENE:

- Children and camp staff should each bring their own individual hand sanitizer for use during the day if desired.
- Children and camp staff will have access to bathrooms, soap and water throughout the day for frequent hand washing.
- Cover coughs and sneezes and then wash hands immediately afterwards for at least 20 seconds with soap and water.
- Please remain at home if sick! Children with fevers or displaying obvious symptoms of severe respiratory illness will not be allowed to attend or remain in camp.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING:

- Maintain appropriate physical distancing when seated and during activities as practical.

CONTACT:

- Groups will attempt to include the same members each day together with the same staff counselors as much as practical.
- Visitors, siblings, and other non-registered children are not permitted at the camp.

SHARING:

- Children must bring their own lunch and drinks to camp each day.
- Water bottles can be refilled at the snack stand as needed by each child.
- Sharing of food, utensils, electronic devices, toys, books, games, etc. is **NOT** permitted.

MEDICATION: Can **NOT** be administered by camp staff, so please remember to give your child any necessary medication at home. Please advise us of any medical circumstances.

COVID-19 INFORMATION: Campers and Staff who are sick, or who have had close contact with a person with COVID-19, or who test positive for COVID-19, should remain at home. Please notify the Camp Director in the event such a situation occurs.
