WELCOME TO SOLEBURY TOWNSHIP'S OUTDOOR SUMMER CAMP

OUR FACILITY:

Camp activities are based at Pat Livezey Park. The entrance is located at the intersection of Hagan and Parkside Drive in Solebury, PA. We have use of the outdoor facilities, athletic fields, playground, snack stand building, and the large covered Pavilion. Accessible indoor bathrooms are located on-site in the snack stand building, with easy access for frequent hand washing.

<u>DROP-OFF:</u> At 9:00 a.m. at the Pavilion. Please stay with your child until check in is completed and you have initialed the sign-in sheet. Parents must check their children in and out upon arrival / departure each day. <u>If arriving prior to 9:00 a.m., please wait with your child, as camp staff can't be responsible for children before 9:00 a.m.</u>

<u>DISMISSAL</u>: Promptly at 3:00 p.m. Campers are dismissed from the same location as morning drop off. Please make sure to notify the Director when picking up your child and sign him/her out. If someone is picking up your child other than a parent or usual caretaker, please send a note to camp. Please be considerate of camp staff by arriving promptly to pick up your child.

WHAT HAPPENS AT CAMP:

Campers are placed in small groups with a counselor and follow a daily schedule, rotating through various activities such as sports, arts & crafts, special events and shows, playground, etc. We operate a very flexible schedule of activities, and our campers can choose what they want to do during free time periods. You will receive an information sheet at the start of each camp week highlighting some of the activities and events that will be taking place.

CONTACTING US:

In an emergency, call the Solebury Township Office at 215-297-5656. They will get a message to us right away. Or call the Director's cell phone at the Camp at 215-828-0392.

<u>LUNCH:</u> Campers must bring their lunch and drinks to camp each day. Please use ice packs in your child's lunch if it needs to stay cold. Every Friday is **PIZZA** Friday – Campers can purchase pizza if they choose and parents will receive an information order sheet on Thursdays.

<u>MEDICATION</u>: Can **NOT** be administered by camp staff, so please remember to give your child any necessary medication at home. Please advise us of any medical circumstances.

<u>COVID-19 INFORMATION:</u> Masking requirements have been lifted by the State of Pennsylvania, the Bucks County Department of Health, and the CDC. Campers who are sick, or who have had close contact with a person with COVID-19, or who test positive for COVID-19, should remain at home. Campers should bring their own individual hand sanitizer if desired.
