

## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR SOLEBURY TOWNSHIP PARK SITES

- 1. HOURS OF OPERATION: Open from Sunup to Sundown.
- 2. SPEED LIMIT: 5 MPH
- 3. MOTOR VEHICLES: Please operate motor vehicles in the areas marked and observe extra caution for children.
- 4. PARKING: Please park all vehicles in appropriately marked spaces.
- 5. RECREATIONAL VEHICLES: Dirt bikes, mopeds, etc. are not to be used in the park site. They should be parked in the designated areas for motor vehicles.
- 6. LITTERING: Please use waste receptacles provided for all trash.
- 7. CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES: The sale, distribution, or consumption of intoxicating alcoholic or controlled substances (such as are now or may later be defined by Federal, State or Township Law or Ordinance) are not permitted.
- 8. DISORDERLY PERSONS: People should behave in an orderly fashion. Abusive language or behavior is unacceptable.
- 9. PARK ENTRANCES: Persons are expected to enter and leave the park through the accesses provided. Please be considerate of the park neighbors.
- 10. PARK PROPERTY: This is your park. Please protect your equipment, buildings, plants, natural environment and fields for the enjoyment of all.
- 11. OPEN BURNING: For the safety of all, open burning is not permitted.
- 12. ANIMALS: All dogs, horses, cats and other animals are to be kept on a 6 ft lead and not permitted to run loose. Additionally, all pet owners are responsible for the prompt and complete removal of their animal's excrement.
- 13. SKATEBOARDS: The use of skateboards on park property is not allowed.
- 14. SAFETY EQUIPMENT: Individuals participating in any sporting activity are advised to wear the proper safety protection and to follow the recommended direction for proper use.
- 15. SMOKING: Smoking/use of tobacco products is NOT permitted in the parks.
- 16. LIGHTS: No lights of any type that are intended to illuminate any area for playing purposes shall be permitted except for the existing lights at the lower fields at Pat Livezey Park.
- 17. SOUND: There shall be no music or broadcasting of any kind over a public speaker or amplified system during the course of any game. There shall be no group band or individual music playing before, during, halftime, or after a game. None of the above is intended to prohibit the playing of the national anthem at the beginning of each game or a "halftime cheer routine with music" using a music system with reasonable volume.
- 18. PERMITS: Any gathering or group, as defined by Township Ordinance, that uses these facilities, must obtain a use permit from Solebury Township in accordance with the current regulations.
