Local Prescription Drug Take-Back Initiative a Success

2.5 Tons of Medications Collected in Bucks County

ike many other police forces across the country, Solebury Township Police participated in the federal Drug Enforcement Administration's fourth national drug collection event April 28, collecting several bags of expired or unwanted prescription and over-the-counter medications at two local collection sites.

The goal of DEA-orchestrated events like this one is to safely remove unessential medications from consumers' medicine cabinets, and thereby (1) reduce the risk of misuse and (2) prevent the contamination of landfills and water sources as a consequence of improper disposal.

During the event, residents surrender medications to law enforcement at advertised collection sites, and police route the drugs for safe disposal.

According to Chief Dominick Bellizzie, the April "take-back" proved to be the county's most successful collection to date.

Bucks County police departments together collected nearly 2.5 tons of prescription and over-the-counter medications, including items dropped off at hosted sites and those deposited in drop boxes, he said.

Between collection events, residents can safely deposit unwanted medications at one of 18 permanent collection boxes, which are located at the Bucks County Courthouse and these police departments:

Supervisors Urge Residents to Sign Up For Email Alerts

The Supervisors urge residents to sign up for Township emails about emergencies and other important matters.

The email address you provide will not be used for any other purpose; the Township does not share email lists with other individuals and/or entities.

The alerts are created, first and foremost, to inform the community of impending natural disasters (such as hurricanes and floods), snow emergencies, road closures, and warnings issued by the Police Department.

They also alert residents to important topics under consideration by the Township and to upcoming community events.

Signing up for email alerts is easy:

- 1. Go to the Solebury website (www.soleburytwp.org).
- 2. Click "Solebury Email Alerts" at the top of the page.
- 3. Enter your email address in the form.
- 4. Click Submit.

That's all it takes to stay abreast of important, up-to-date information.

Solebury Red Hawks Take Div. 1 Basketball Championship

A First for Township Basketball Program

n a stunning display of skill and power, the Solebury Red Hawks-the 12-year-old boys basketball travel team sponsored ▲ by the Township Parks and Recreation Dept.—defeated Springford Township 44-28 in the Inter-County Basketball Association's Division 1 championship at Upper Moreland Middle School, taking the title and earning a place in local history.

According to Parks and Recreation Director Dudley Rice, the victory marks the first time a Solebury basketball team won a Division 1 Title.

"Division 1 is the highest level, the elite of all divisions," he said. The win was also notable, he said, because Springford was seeded number one, having entered the game with only one loss for the entire

"The Red Hawks jumped out to a dominating early lead and never relinquished it," the director recounted. "They shut down Springford's high-octane offense. By the fourth quarter, the Red Hawks had total control of the court, to the cheers of the overflow crowd."

"It was the team's awesome defensive strategy and aggressive shooting style that allowed them to capture the title and championship trophy," he concluded.

The Red Hawks coaches praised the team's hard work and dedication throughout the entire season.

EAC Offers Well and Septic Tips

While parts of Solebury are serviced by public water and sewer services, a large portion of the Township uses on-lot well-water and septic systems.

In effect, most residents operate their own personal utilities and need to perform regular maintenance to protect the water supply and preserve their septic systems.

Replacing a failed system can cost more than \$30,000 and can be very disruptive to a household.

According to the Solebury Environmental Advisory Committee (EAC), owner maintenance is the most important factor in keeping septic systems operating properly.

The EAC offers the following top-10 actions to help residents safeguard the integrity of their septic systems and protect the Township's water quality:

- 1. Have your septic tank pumped every 2-3 years, regardless of whether your on-lot sewage system has problems.
- 2. Use less water—less water causes less stress on the system and prevents overload.
- 3. Have the tank regularly inspected by a professional, and keep records of all inspections, pumping, and other maintenance.
- 4. Do not flush coffee grounds, dental floss, disposable diapers, kitty litter, cigarette butts, bandages, or other materials that can damage your system.
- 5. Never pour harsh chemicals into your septic system (e.g., bleach, latex paint, drain cleaners, cooking oil).
- 6. If you have a garbage disposal, severely restrict its use.
- 7. Do not use chemical or biological enzyme additives.
- 8. Whenever possible give your septic system a break—for example, spread laundry machine use over a period of days instead of doing 5-6 loads in one day.
- 9. Know where your septic system is located and keep that area free of deep rooted plants and trees.
- 10. Never allow heavy construction equipment to be operated on the drainfield.

All proceeds from the sale of tiles and license plates benefit Parks and Recreation programs; they are available at Township Hall during regular business hours.





Police Urge Caution Around Motorcycles



The return of warm weather also brings the usual increase in the number of motorcycles on Township roads.

To help avoid accidents and injuries, the Solebury Police Dept. urges residents to be cautious when sharing the road with motorcycles—particularly when turning onto Township roads from blind driveways and intersections.

"Motorcycles are sometimes difficult to see and extra caution must be taken," noted Police Chief Dominick Bellizzie.

"Noise is another problem related to motorcycles at this time of year," he said. "The police department will be vigilant and will do everything legally possible to ensure that all motorcycles operated in the Township have proper muffler systems."
