<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES:</u> MOTION 23-06 On a motion by Dan Morrin Jr., second by Kevin Campbell, the minutes of the March 23, 2023 regular meeting were unanimously approved.

### FINANCE REPORT

Board members reviewed the P&R budget for April 2023. In response to a question about mowing, the Director noted that all parks are being mowed, however, some areas in each park are not mowed as part of the Township's sustainability program. The Reeder Road property and most of the Route 202 property are not being mowed (those properties are not parks).

Dan Morrin Jr. brought up issues of people driving through Solebury Park and allowing dog to run loose unleashed. The Director pointed out that a simple call to the police will send them right out to the park to handle those situations.
