Agreement Authorizing Hough Associates to Collect 2013 Residential and Commercial Recycling Data and Prepare PA DEP 904 Recycling Grant Application for Solebury Township

Solebury Township authorizes Hough Associates to collect its 2013 recycling data. Hough Associates will prepare a joint 2013 grant application with other area municipalities if the application increases the recycling grant to Solebury Township. Hough Associates will file an individual application for the Township if it does not want to be included in a joint application.

Hough Associates will:

- Prepare and mail letters and data collection forms to haulers that collected recyclables in Solebury Township requesting that they report their 2013 recycling tonnage and to identify where they took the recyclables for processing.
- Prepare and mail a letter to all recycling processors that handle recycling generated in the Township requesting that they report 2013 recycling residue rate.
- Contact all haulers and processors that did not respond to the mailing.
- Compile the 2013 recycling data reported to the Township and to Hough Associates in both hard copy and on a computer database.
- Prepare and file the 2013 Bucks County Recycling Survey Report due February 2014
- Analyze the benefits of a joint grant application with other Bucks County municipalities
- Prepare and file the joint 2013 904 Recycling Performance Grant Application forms with other municipalities on or before the 2014 filing deadline.

Solebury Township agrees to provide Hough Associates with a current list of commercial entities that operated in the Township in 2013 and a letter identifying Hough Associates as the company authorized to collect its recycling data.
